DIOCESAN DAY FOR CATECHISTS – SATURDAY, 12TH NOVEMBER

The annual diocesan Day for Catechists, this year, was postponed due to rail strikes. It will now take place on Saturday 12th

November at the Amigo Hall and St George's Cathedral, starting with registration from 10am and ending with Mass at 4pm. This is an in-service training day for all catechists in the diocese (including those involved in Liturgy of the Word for Children and the RCIA process), and a day of support for them in their ministry.

BISHOP PATRICK LYNCH JUBILEE

This year marks the Golden Jubilee of ordination to the priesthood of Bishop Patrick Lynch.
