PARISH PENTECOST

On 19th May, we shall celebrate the Coming of the Holy Spirit on the Disciples and into our lives and world once more. This is also a special day for the Spiritans who serve St Joseph's as they were founded on Pentecost Sunday in 1703. We pray at this time that the grace and guidance of the Holy Spirit will be with all Christians and especially with all Spiritans, in over 60 Countries and territories around the world, as they serve the Gospel guided and inspired by the Holy Spirit. At all Masses, Pentecost weekend, there will be an Appeal for the Missions of the Spiritans, and a collection for these Missions at each Mass. Special Gift Aid envelopes will be available. The Spiritans invite you all to a social afternoon after 12noon mass. We need donations of food and drinks for the occasion - please speak to the clergy if you can help. In preparation for this special event, we will have Novena to the Holy Spirit at every mass from the 10th May.
