A reminder that the annual service for those that have been harmed by abuse is coming up on the 25th September 2024 at 6.30pm @ St George's Cathedral led by Archbishop John Wilson. At the end of the service, everyone will be invited to tie a ribbon in support of those that have been harmed by abuse. There will be light refreshments afterwards and a place for anyone to talk to the safeguarding team. A new hymn, written for survivors will be introduced at the service. The hymn is called "Ribbons of Hope" written by Peter Rose and Anne Conlon. It is a unique hymn, that at last gives a voice to victims and survivors of abuse and all those that are or have been affected by such abuse. The hymn speaks with complete honesty, holding nothing back. It then asks our loving Lord for his healing and his love in order to help ease all the hurt and the pain.
